4 Conjunction

The coordinating conjunctions in Dagaare are the following ones: *à, àné, kyé, kyé kà, béé,* and *kyé béé*.

- (1) *nààná dà yí lá sàkúúrĩ kúlí à tè zéng dĩ-ré bó-má*
Naana PAST get-out FOC school go-home CONJ go sit eat-IMP thing-PL
'Naana went home from school and sat down eating food.' [Bodomo, 2000, p. 39]
